

Handling of University Activities in the Post-COVID-19 Era

Based on the national and local governments' policies in relation to COVID-19, TUAT policies on university activities (on-, off- campus activities) from April 2023 will be as follows.

(The "Notice" dated June 27, 2022 will be abolished.)

Mask-wearing while performing educational and research activities will not be mandatory (please be careful not to force someone to wear or not to wear masks).

While paying attention to coughing manners and basic measures for infection control ((1) Avoiding the "Three Cs"; (2) Maintaining physical distancing between people; (3) Hand sanitization (e.g. washing hands); and (4) Ventilation), make decisions and correspond by yourself about taking measures.

(Depending on the situation of the COVID-19 spread in the society changes in the future, we may amend the content of the following.)

If you have questions or concerns, contact the Student Support Office of the campus you belong to if you are a student; contact the General Affairs Section of the office, etc. you belong to, or the Student Support Office of the campus you belong to if you are a faculty/administrative staff member.

Activities involving non-TUAT members (external business operators, other university members, etc.)	<p><Academic conferences, university festivals, etc.></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> After taking measures (3) and (4) (be aware of (1) and (2)), proceed with the academic conferences or symposiums For events involving eating or drinking, such as university festivals, proceed with the events after taking measures (1) to (4) (setting restrictions on the number of participants, etc. is unnecessary) <p><Extra curricular activities></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> There will be no restrictions on the use of sport facilities <p><Filming a drama, movie, etc.></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> After taking measures (1) to (4) and arranging with the respective faculty or office, you may determine whether to accept or not to accept the request for filming on campus
